'Right Here' shortlist announced

A shortlist of organisations applying to run *Right Here* pilot sites has been announced by PHF and the Mental Health Foundation.

The organisations, from across all parts of the UK, will each work with the *Right Here* team to develop their proposals, before a final selection of up to four sites will be chosen.

The pilot sites will be supported with funding for the next few years to provide mental health services for young people, help to increase awareness of mental health issues and build resilience in the population.

Rob Bell, PHF Social Justice Programme Manager, said: "We are delighted with the range and quality of applications we have had to *Right Here*. Over 200 organisations from across the UK applied - an indication of growing recognition that we need to improve the quality and delivery of support to young people, to prevent them from developing mental health problems. We will now work closely with the shortlisted proposals as they develop their plans for the second stage of the process."
